### Topics:

- Review of December Meeting Minutes/ Approval
  - Approved, no changes
- Director of Parks and Recreation Summary-
  - Reviewed Brian's January report
- Recreation Center Update- No update
- DRP Playground Replacement 2026 project

- Brace road usage
  - When the weather breaks, walk the property and layout gravel parking lot, RC track, disc golf course
  - Drew mentioned getting anything going on this property would be a win
- Fischer's Park Improvements- no update
- Dryer Rd Park Improvements- Gabe provided update
  - Jump Line- pursuing manmade take-offs and landing, but not full asphalt, still looking for funding for the project, additional meetings have not be set
  - Pump Track- still working towards a paved pump track and kids bicycle playground, working with a family to collaborate on a design with GROC, speaking with GROC about matching funds, additional meetings have not be set
- CAC Membership
  - 7 members total (2 town, 2 village, 2 either, 1 student)

- Village member- Vacant, question is can a town board member serve on the CAC as a village member capacity?
  - Is there an age limitation on voting members of the CAC?
- 2026 Initiatives
    - Adjacent lot to P&R facility- what would the community want? Would the CAC drive an initiative to review previous input from residents (master plan, interested party survey, etc) and perhaps reach out using P&R social media platform to prioritize need. For example, use the property for a turf field house, pool, indoor ice rink...
    - Brace Road usage- kickoff the low hanging fruit phase 1 (gravel lot, rc track, disc golf). Contact little league stakeholders for their interest in partnering to build a “clover” baseball/softball facility on the property in a future phase. Contact pickleball stakeholders to include courts in a future phase.
