Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation...

I hope that this note finds you well and enjoying these last weeks of summer as many of us prepare to head back to school and work our way into the fall season. This spring and summer, we completed two significant park improvement projects at **Dryer Road Park** with the construction of a **"new" box rink** featuring an artificial turf and enlarged playing surface as well as the renovation and re-construction of our mountain bike park. I would like to thank the box rink project committee of Town Councilman Dave Tantillo, Victor Central School District Boys Lacrosse Coach Jim Andre (and former member of the Towns' Parks and Recreation Citizens' Advisory Committee), former Victor Youth Soccer Board member Paul Moszak and Mike Stockman, Assistant Director of Parks and Recreation for their work in support of the project. The outdoor box rink is one of only two facilities of its kind in the Rochester-Finger Lakes region and will bring additional soccer and lacrosse playing opportunities for youth and adults.

Our **"new" bike park** at Dryer Road Park was developed through our partnership with Genesee Regional Off-Road Cyclists (GROC) who raised Five-Thousand Dollars for the purchase of materials and equipment for the project and donated hundreds of hours towards its re-birth. The bike park features a push bike track, a pump track and beginner / intermediate and advanced jump lines for our widely acclaimed mountain bike facility. In addition, the entrance / exit trail was re-routed to accommodate the new jump lines and modifications were made to other trails on the front side of the park to increase riding options for beginner level riders. As you can imagine, this was a major effort given our challenging weather this 717. Kudos to GROC volunteers including Paul Moszak, Christian Waddington, Adam Reitz and Jeff Wright for their leadership and sweat equity in the project!

It has been a long term goal of our Department and Victor Hiking Trails to have a **connector trail between the Auburn Trail and Dryer Road Park**. With the generous support of the Clarise, Elder, and Kingsley families who granted us the permits necessary to make the trail connection through their land, we cleared and opened the trail for use in June. The "new" connector trail travels through the subdivisions of Auburn Hills and Stonington Ridge providing off-road access for bicyclists and pedestrians. Trail maps can be found at www.victorhikingtrails.org. The Town and Village of Victor are well known for their sixty plus (60+) miles of multi-use trails, which connect to neighborhoods, parks, local businesses as well as the Towns of Farmington, Mendon, Perinton and Pittsford... please get out there and Explore Victor Trails this fall!

Thank you for your past support of our recreation programs and facilities but if you are "new" to our area, WELCOME TO VICTOR...we are looking forward to providing you many recreation opportunities in the coming months and years!

SWIM LESSON LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

Note: If needed, participants may be moved to a more appropriate level on the first day of class.

- **Introduction to Level 1:** This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are ready for more independence than the tot program. 





Auburn Trail

Lehigh Valley Trail

Located on Victor -Egypt Road (County Road 9), across from the Valentown Road intersection, this living classroom has an emphasis on preservation and restoration of New York State's official bird, the Bluebird. A one mile trail looped trail traverses the property through open fields and woods. This trail enables park visitors to see bluebirds in their natural habitat. The renovated Butler Cottage is available for family gatherings, parties or business meetings. Included is a newly constructed handicapped accessible fishing dock.
