

## Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation

During the summer and fall, the Department and its Parks and Recreation Citizens' Advisory Committee held three (3) public input gatherings for residents to provide comment on the update of our Parks and Recreation Master Plan. In addition, we initiated a community-wide survey seeking feedback about our resident's current park and recreation facility use and recreation program participation patterns.

Together with our consultant team at Bayer Landscape Architecture, we interviewed Department stakeholder groups including youth sports organizations, hiking and mountain biking trail groups, and the variety of civic organizations that we collaborate with for projects throughout the Town and Village of Victor! This information will be used to determine priorities so that we can assign costs and determine a schedule for implementing the recommendations outlined in the adopted plan.

Some of the initial comments and central themes that we received during the public outreach portion of the project included the desire for a community splash pad, a dog park, a town-owned recreation center, an ice rink, an outdoor pool and new trails within the community! Residents have told us that we offer a diverse line-up of children's programming, but that we should have more programming for individuals with disabilities as well as more concerts and special events. This is great information and will be included in the updated master plan to help guide us in the future.

Just switching gears a little from long-range Department planning to a project that you can look forward to this spring will be the development of an accessible seating area at the Victor Municipal Park bandshell. The Department received a grant from the Victor-Farmington Rotary to help us construct a concrete pad and extend the sidewalk at the facility so that park visitors that use wheelchairs or mobility devices can have a better experience. This was an item noted as a near-term goal in the (2017) Inclusion plan. Kudos to the Victor-Farmington Rotary and its members for improving the lives of others once again in the Victor community!

From our Department to you and your entire family, we wish you the best during this holiday season and hope that you have a safe and healthy New Year!

## BOATING - NEW YORK SAFE BOATING SAFETY COURSE

New York State requires all individuals born on or after 5/1/1996 to successfully complete an approved course in boater education in order to operate a motorboat. This course requires a minimum of 8 hours of classroom instruction. Students must pass a final exam with a score of 76%. Students will receive a temporary boating safety certificate upon completion of the course. Students 18 years of age and older will be required to pay a \$10 fee to NYS for issuance of a permanent boating safety certificate. Permanent boating safety certificates do not expire. A minimum of 6 participants needed for the program to run. Check the Victor Parks and Recreation web site for additional class dates.



### Introduction to Level 1:

This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are comfortable performing bobs, putting their face in, blowing bubbles and holding onto the wall unassisted in 3 foot 8 inch deep water. They will work on floating independently, flutter kicking and rolling over onto their back. These skills are essential in keeping this age group safe in both pools and lakes. Upon passing this level, it is possible the child may be ready for Level 2 (Instructor's discretion).

### Level 1 (Beginner 1):

If your child is under the age of 6, please refer to Intro to Level 1. Level 1 is for children 6 and older who are able to stand in the shallow end independently. They will work on putting their face in the water, blowing bubbles and floating on their front or back.

### Level 2 (Beginner 2):

Children in this group can float a little and feel comfortable with their faces in the water, but are still working on making progress through the water.

### Level 3 (Beginner 3):

This group can swim in the shallow end with their faces in the water, but continue to work on the confidence to feel comfortable in water over their head.

### Level 4

#### (Advanced Beginner):

Children can swim in the deep end but are working on rhythmic breathing on front crawl and performing the elementary backstroke.
