Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation

The crack of the baseball bat, the sounds and sightings of the Eastern Bluebird and the daffodils rising up from our gardens are all telltale signs that milder weather patterns are upon us in western New York. In our Department of Parks and Recreation, we mark the changing of the seasons from winter to spring in a variety of ways. For our staff of recreation professionals, we are recruiting and hiring summer employees which will support our youth camps and aquatics programs that are found in this brochure. From a special events perspective, we are promoting our popular concerts and movies in the park as well as hosting parades and fishing derbies. And from the parks and trails operations arena, we are staging construction projects, putting away the snowplows and prepping our mowers.

An annual rite of spring which is just around the corner is the Village of Victor Tree Board's **Arbor Day Planting and Celebration**. This year's event will take place on Saturday, **April 27th** in the Rothbury Circle neighborhood which is off School Street in the Village. A large contingent of resident volunteers, community service organizations, school groups and staff will be busy planting a variety of bare root trees to beautify our community. The event is typically capped off with a hotdog cookout! The Village of Victor recently received a grant from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation to develop and adopt a Tree Management Plan due to the efforts of this steadfast group of supporters.

In March, we kicked off our monthly "Speaker's Series" with a message for our active adults from newly elected Ontario County Sheriff Kevin Henderson. This new program addition to our monthly line-up of luncheons, trips, tours, hikes and bikes will be an activity to look forward to this spring and summer. Our summer concert series at Victor Municipal Park will feature great sounds from the likes of Ruby Shooz, amazing barbeque from local favorites Dinosaur BBQ and newcomers Smokin Pete's as well as local craft breweries. In addition, Victor Hiking Trails will host its annual **National Trails Day on Sunday, June 2nd** starting at 8:30 AM and the Victor Garden Club will offer its annual Plant Sale on Saturday, May 4th at 9:00 – 11:00 AM.



SWIM LESSON LEVELS DESCRIPTIONS

Note: If you are unsure which level your child belongs in, please contact Christine Winter at (585) 742-0145 or cwinter@town-victor-ny.us

Introduction to Level 1:

This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are ready for more independence than the tot program. They will work on floating independently, flutter kicking and rolling over onto their back. These skills are essential in keeping this age group safe in both pools and lakes. Upon passing this level, it is possible the child may be ready for level 2 (Instructor's discretion).

Level 1 (Beginner 1):

If your child is under the age of 6, please refer to Intro to Level 1. This group is for children who are able to stand in the shallow end independently. They will work on putting their face in the water, blowing bubbles and floating on their front or back.

Level 2 (Beginner 2):

Children in this group can float and feel comfortable with their faces in the water, but are still working on making independent forward progress.

Level 3 (Beginner 3):

This group can swim in the shallow end with their faces in the water, but continue to work on the confidence to feel comfortable in water over their head. This class has a large focus on learning front crawl, backstroke, and elementary backstroke.

Level 4 (Advanced Beginner):

This class takes place in the deep end. Children will work on refining the front crawl and backstroke. Children will learn breaststroke and sidestroke.

Level 5 (Intermediate):

Swimmers can rhythmic breathe on front crawl and perform the elementary backstroke but will continue to work on the breaststroke, sidestroke, and/or back crawl.

Level 6 (Swimmer):

This group can perform the six basic strokes: front crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, back crawl and butterfly. Level 6 now has four components that will be covered in the lesson: Personal Water Safety, Pre-Lifeguard Training, Fitness Swimmer and Fundamentals of Diving.



AUBURN TRAIL

This accessible trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

BOUGHTON PARK

Stirnie Road & Boughton Road

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. DRYER ROAD PARK

7405 Dryer Road

7350 State Route 251
