





MISSION STATEMENT

The Town of Victor Parks and Recreation Department is dedicated to offering ALL residents a balanced system of parklands, preservation of open space, and broad-based leisure opportunities that will foster growth of healthy lifestyles.

Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation

The Town of Victor is nestled in between the Finger Lakes and the City of Rochester. For the past three decades, the Town has seen consistent growth in its residential and commercial footprint. For that reason, our residents place a high priority on the quality of life aspects of our community. This includes the preservation of open space, the development of a balanced parks system including passive and active recreation opportunities, an expansive network of trails and sidewalks, and a wide array of programs and services. Most recently, the Town Board adopted an update to our **Parks and Recreation Master Plan**, which will help serve as a tool to guide our future initiatives within the Department. Some of the immediate project areas that we are looking at are the Department's current indoor space issue at its existing recreation facility at Lehigh Crossing Road in Fishers as well as improvements to Fishers Park, Victor Municipal Park and MaryFrances Bluebird Haven. Although we have owned the 16 acre Paparone Park since 2005, the recently adopted plan calls for a series of phased in improvements which will develop it into the Town's next active recreation facility. The 2019 Parks and Recreation Master Plan update is available at our website at www.victorny.org. Stay tuned for more!

This summer and fall, the Department partnered with local **Boy Scout Troops** and **Victor Hiking Trails** to develop several projects in the community. With the support of both organizations, **Tanner Ritz** of Troop 61 designed, constructed and installed "new" wayfinding signage in Fishers Park. **Ethan Davis** of Troop 60 constructed a "new" boardwalk and bridge in the 100 Arce Woods trail system. As I write this note, **Kyle Dempsey** is in the process of designing and constructing a kiosk and bench for the "new" Lane Road shared use path near Taylor Rise. Finally, **Jared Phillips** will be constructing and installing several "new" benches at Boughton Park later this year. Community based projects like these efforts by local Eagle Scout candidates provide not only a learning experience for the Scout but also an opportunity for our Department and Victor Hiking Trails to work together. In closing, our Department would like to thank and recognize **Town Councilman Dave Tantillo** for the past eight years' service on the Victor Town Board and the Parks and Recreation Citizens' Advisory Committee. Dave advocated for and spearheaded several community-wide projects including the Dryer Road Park Box Rink, the Safe Routes to School and Victor Community Connectivity federally-funded sidewalk projects, the 2015 Town of Victor Comprehensive Plan and the 2018 Route 96 Transformative Corridor Project. Most recently, Dave led the 2019 Parks and Recreation Master Plan update from concept to completion! The entire Victor community, especially its most precious asset – its children and families – will benefit for decades from Dave's tireless efforts. Kudos to Dave Tantillo for his years of commitment to the Town of Victor and for a job well done. We will miss Dave, but we know that he is always in the parks and recreation corner! Perhaps we will see you in early December at *Christmas in the Village* or out in one of your fabulous parks? Nevertheless, have a great holiday season whether you are traveling or spending it with us at Victor Parks and Recreation.



WREATHS ACROSS AMERICA

James Cooke American Legion Post 931 will be participating in this program where a Christmas wreath will be placed at the gravesite of every soldier buried in Victor's cemeteries. It was started in 2007.

In 2008, over 300 locations held wreath-laying ceremonies in every state, Puerto Rico and 24 overseas cemeteries. Over 100,000 wreaths were placed on veterans' graves. Over 60,000 volunteers participated. And that year, December 13, 2008 was unanimously voted by the US Congress as "Wreaths Across America Day".

In 2014, Wreaths Across America and its national network of volunteers laid over 700,000 memorial wreaths at 1,000 locations in the United States and beyond, including ceremonies at the Pearl Harbor Memorial, as well as Bunker Hill, Valley Forge and the sites of the September 11 tragedies. This was accomplished with help from 2,047 fundraising groups, corporate contributions, and donations of trucking, shipping, and thousands of helping hands. The organization's goal of covering Arlington National Cemetery was met in 2014 with the placement of 226,525 wreaths.

The wreath-laying is still held annually, on the second or third Saturday of December. WAA's annual pilgrimage from Harrington, Maine to Arlington National Cemetery has become known as the world's largest veterans' parade, stopping at schools, monuments, veterans' homes and communities all along the way to remind people how important it is to remember, honor and teach.

Locally, James Cooke Post 931 hopes to raise money enough to place wreaths on the over 500 gravesites in Victor. On December 14, The Legion will need helping hands, trucks in order to move and deliver the wreaths to the 3 local cemeteries. 



Introduction to Level 1

This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are comfortable performing bobs, putting their face in, blowing bubbles and holding onto the wall unassisted in 3 foot 8 inch deep water.. They will work on floating independently, flutter kicking and rolling over onto their back. These skills are essential in keeping this age group safe in both pools and lakes. Upon passing this level, it is possible the child may be ready for level 2 (Instructor's discretion).

Level 1 (Beginner 1):

If your child is under the age of 6, please refer to "Introduction to Level 1". This group is for children who are able to stand in the shallow end independently. They will work on putting their face in the water, blowing bubbles and floating on their front or back.

Level 2 (Beginner 2):

Children in this group can float and feel comfortable with their faces in the water, but are still working on making independent forward progress.

Level 3 (Beginner 3):

This group can swim in the shallow end with their faces in the water, but continue to work on the confidence to feel comfortable in water over their head. This class has a large focus on learning front crawl, backstroke, and elementary backstroke.

Level 4 (Advanced Beginner):

This class takes place in the deep end. Children will work on refining the front crawl and backstroke. Children will learn breaststroke and sidestroke.



WHAT IS TIES?

Together Including Every Student (TIES), developed in 1997 by two parents of children who have disabilities, promotes the participation of students and young adults who have developmental disabilities in inclusive, organized extracurricular and community activities through the support of trained student volunteers.

- **Participants** who have developmental disabilities join activities where they can develop recreational interests, learn about their community, and have fun with peers.
- **Peer volunteers** learn how to support participants according to their individual needs, gain more understanding of disabilities and diversity, and make a positive difference in a peer's life.
- **Activity leaders** create an experience where all individuals and talents are included, and promote community awareness and inclusion.

HOW DOES TIES WORK?

TIES is currently in place in more than 30 school districts throughout the Western, Central, and Finger Lakes regions of New York.

TIES Coordinators work closely with the school districts to identify eligible participants, recruit and train peer volunteers, communicate with activity leaders, and make necessary arrangements for each activity.

Activities can be -

- A single event, such as a school dance or after-school football game.
- An ongoing class, such as cooking, dance, martial arts, music, or gymnastics.
- Ongoing participation in a community organization, such as Scouts.
- A Drumming Circle.

Feel free to ask about an activity your son or daughter may be interested in.

Participants are children and young adults between the ages of 8 and 21 who have developmental disabilities. Individuals receive an application from the TIES Coordinator that asks about interests and what support is needed to be successful. Support is individualized and can be in physical, social/behavioral, or language areas. Participants list the activities they would like to join or request information about desired activities. The Coordinator discusses the chosen activities and needed support with the participant and/or parents. An individualized plan is developed that guides the peer volunteer's support. The Coordinator also communicates with the activity leader to introduce the TIES program and assess what individual accommodations may be needed.

We encourage you to help your child take advantage of the many extracurricular activities that our schools and community have to offer by participating in TIES!





AUBURN TRAIL

This improved trail has a stone dust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

BOUGHTON PARK

[Stirnie Road & Boughton Road](#)

Situated in the Town of East Bloomfield, this passive park has joint ownership by the Towns of Victor, East Bloomfield and West Bloomfield. The park includes two, large ponds, several miles of multi-use trails, canoe / kayak launches and racks and numerous places for a family picnic! Recommendations for the future include a lodge with restrooms, fishing docks and improvements to the park trail system. The park is only open to residents of Victor, East Bloomfield and West Bloomfield. Park permits are free, but required by the independent Boughton Park Commission.



DRYER ROAD PARK

[7405 Dryer Road](#)

Well known in our region for its expansive trail network and pump track that caters to mountain bikers of all skill levels; the park also features rectangular athletic fields, a children's playground, year-round restrooms, a picnic shelter and an artificial surface, box sports rink. Victor's largest park shares its eastern border with Ganondagan State Historic Site and has a trail connection to both the Fort Hill area and the "new" Seneca Art and Culture Center. Future plans for Dryer Road Park include additional athletic fields and a splash pad

FISHERS PARK

[7929 Main Street, Fishers](#)

Located in the Hamlet of Fishers, Victor's oldest dedicated park provides recreational opportunities including hiking, fishing, nature appreciation and tennis / pickleball courts. Multi-use trails meander through the park across wooded ridges, through wetlands, along the banks of Irondequoit Creek and through a meadow that will provide you with exceptional views. There is a picnic area with tables and a seasonal restroom. Future plans include an outdoor classroom/adventure play area and a children's playground.

HARLAN FISHER PARK

[85 Lynaugh Road](#)

This park features a perimeter wooded area that creates a natural buffer to the surrounding neighborhoods. Park amenities include a children's playground, picnic area with tables, and a seasonal restroom. Future plans include a dog park, outdoor classroom/adventure or nature play area, and a picnic shelter.

LEHIGH CROSSING PARK

[7350 State Route 251](#)

The park acquires its name from the three former railroads that once occupied the land - the New York Central (Auburn Line), the Lehigh Valley, and the Rochester and Eastern Rapid Railway (Trolley Line), whose trail corridors still border the park. With woods, wetlands and a pond located within this passive park; numerous birds, waterfowl and critters call this park home! There are several miles of multi-use trails with bridges, boardwalks and wildlife viewing opportunities as well as a seasonal restroom. Future plans include a wood-decked bridge on the Trolley Trail to carry park users over the Lehigh Valley Trail and an outdoor classroom with education stations.

LEHIGH VALLEY TRAIL

This improved trail has a stone dust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings.

MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN

235 County Route 9

Gifted to the Town of Victor by Robert Butler in 1997, this park for special experiences includes an accessible fishing dock with a pond, looped multi-use trail, an enclosed lodge, a community garden and numerous bird nesting boxes suitable for New York's Official State Bird! Included is a newly constructed handicapped accessible fishing dock. Future plans include an outdoor classroom, an environmental education center / area and an arboretum highlighting native trees found within the region and throughout the northeast. MEAD SQUARE PARK

39 West Main Street

The 16 acre parcel was acquired by the Town in 2005 and while it is not currently developed, the existing master plan for the park includes provisions for a community recreation center, athletic fields, pickleball courts, a picnic area and pavilion, and an outdoor classroom with wetland education stations and an adventure play area! The park also boasts the potential for bicycle and pedestrian connectivity to Victor Municipal Park (located on the west side of Brace Road) and to the Auburn Trail (located to the south).

One of Victor's most active parks, Victor Municipal Park has a variety of user experiences including a timber-frame picnic shelter, a children's playground, an accessible fishing dock with a stocked pond, an enclosed lodge and a special events amphitheater and bandshell. The park plays host to our annual summer concert series and youth fishing derby as well as numerous community gatherings and events! Future plans include a splash pad and additional multi-use trails to connect to the neighborhoods which surround this park.

This neighborhood park situated off County Road 9 has multiple locations including rectangular athletic fields, a children's playground with a gazebo, and a sledding hill with multi-use trails on the park's drumlin. There are convenient parking areas at all locations and a seasonal restroom near the athletic fields. Future plans include a dog park area, additional athletic fields and athletic courts, and a pavilion with year-round restrooms.
