Challenge and opportunity were certainly the two words that kept echoing through my head in recent months. With the closure of the recreation aspect of Department's operation for a full year that spanned several seasons, many of the successes that we had achieved over the past two decades seemed to be distant memories. However when COVID-19 vaccines increased across our region and public health and safety protocols were gradually lifted, we were able to begin offering spring and summer activities again. While the recreation offerings weren't up to our usual high standards given many limitations, we had to find ways to engage residents in all the wonderful aspects that a recreation program brings to a community!

I hope that you and your family had the opportunity to attend one of the many concerts in the park this summer or perhaps you are anxiously anticipating our "Back to School Movie & Campout" at Dryer Road Park on August 28th? "New" camps emerged this summer including our "Kinder Nature Camp," "Jr. Ranger Nature Explorers," and "Epic Adventures: Summer Sessions Mountain Bike Camp." Coach Jerry LaVigne and I had a super time with our Jr. Golf League at Victor Hills G.C. this summer and we rebranded popular activities including "Bingo & Pizza Nights" and senior citizen luncheons by taking them into our parks while the Recreation Center remained closed.

This fall we will resume hours and recreation activities at the Victor Recreation Center with the return of our Victor Recreational Afterschool Program (VRAP), preschool and youth programs including Come and Play, Music Together, the youth basketball league and numerous afterschool programs with Coach Steve Hendrickson. Next summer, we will be back in action with our widely popular day camp and swim lessons and as usual there will be a variety of "new" activities and events that we hope will catch your eye! I would

like to thank you in advance for your patience as we get project restart through its initial seasons and I appreciate any and all ideas on how we can better meet your needs.

Our Victor Parks and Recreation Citizens' Advisory Committee and consultant team from Bayer Landscape Architecture have recently launched into a future Dog Park project which was identified as a near-term priority in the (2019) Parks and Recreation Master Plan. In July, we held an Open House at Harlan Fisher Park to kick off the project and public input will continue this fall. Please contact me at (585) 742-0141 with any questions or look for updates throughout the fall at www.victoryny.org. Adam Reitz from our trails crew has been working with the members of Victor Hiking Trails (VHT) and Genesee Regional Off-Road Cyclists (GROC) to assist them with their trail maintenance and planning efforts on our community-valued trail system. Nate O'Connor, a local Boy Scout worked with Adam and

the GROC trail crew on two "new" drops in the Dryer Road Park network as part of his Eagle Scout rank. These will offer new challenges for mountain bikers visiting the park!

On your next visit to Mary Frances Bluebird Haven, be sure to check out the many park improvements made this spring including a "new" bird blind, several "new" bird nesting boxes and posts, and pond plantings to improve the health of that natural feature. These enhancements were designed, developed and constructed by local Boy Scout Douglas Tavolette as his Eagle Scout project. Kudos to Doug, his parents and support crew for a great effort!



In closing, thanks for your support and care as we navigated the recent changes to the Department of Parks and Recreation's operation. We are committed to moving forward.

BABY BLADES

Introduce your baby to the ice! The "Baby Blade's" program is designed to get young children excited about being on the ice. Introduce your child to skating in a FUN way! Kids get a chance to play on the ice and much more. Baby Blades class focuses on gently aquatinting young children with the ice and developing coordination in a creative & playful environment. There will be a 25-minute instructional period where the instructor will cover topics such as falling down, getting up, marching in place and moving, backward wiggles, stopping and more. The remaining 25 minutes will be designated for free-skate practicing and games with some assistance from helpers. Some first timers are a bit cautious of the ice but with their parent on the ice they learn to have fun. Skaters should bring gloves, leggings, snow pants, and other warm clothes. Helmets are strongly recommended. An additional fee of \$17.50 per child for U.S. Figure Skating must be paid at your first class prior to skating. Classes are divided into two 25-minute group sessions.

GET OUT AND EXPLORE VICTOR'S PARKS

AUBURN TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

BOUGHTON PARK

Stirnie Road & Boughton Road

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. Permits for the park can be obtained at Victor Town Clerks office, 85 East Main Street. Please bring proof of residency (NYS ID and car registration). The permits are free to Victor Residents.

DRYER ROAD PARK

7405 Dryer Road

This 132-acre park is the site of athletic fields and a box sports rink. There is a multiage playground for children, year-round restrooms facilities, and a picnic shelter, which is available for casual use or reservation. There are 15 miles of multi-use trails for a variety of skill levels and abilities. Please sign in at the trailhead kiosk and pick up a trail map prior to setting out to explore the trails. The park links Victor's Native American past with our future with pathways to Ganondagan State Historic Site. Trail maps can also be downloaded at www.mygroc.com and www.VictorNY.org.

FISHERS PARK

7929 Main Street, Fishers

Located in the hamlet of Fishers, this 93 acre park is a diversity of passive and active recreation opportunities. Visitors can see a multitude of wildlife from deer, squirrels, and other woodland creatures to waterfowl and trout that spawn in the spring. Two tennis courts are available for the tennis players in your family. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike. Trails meander through the park across wooded ridges, through wetland areas, and along the banks of Irondequoit Creek. New acreage off Old Dutch Road provides you with many new trails with beautiful vistas. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike, snowshoe or cross-country ski.

LEHIGH CROSSING PARK

7350 State Route 251

Lehigh Crossing Park is located off of Victor-Mendon Road (State Route 251) near Cork Road and Route 96. This 54 acre park plays host to several miles of multi-use trails, vehicle parking area and gazebo. With woods, wetlands and ponds located within this passive park, numerous birds, waterfowl and critters find this park an exceptional place to call home. Bring binoculars!

LEHIGH VALLEY TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings.

MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN

235 County Route 9

Located on Victor-Egypt Road (County Road 9), across from the Valentown Road intersection, this living classroom has an emphasis on preservation and restoration of New York State's official bird, the Bluebird. A one mile looped trail traverses the property through open fields and woods. This trail enables park visitors to see bluebirds in their natural habitat. The renovated Butler Cottage is available for family gatherings, parties or business meetings. Included is a newly constructed handicapped accessible fishing dock.
