

## **AUBURN TRAIL**

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

## **BOUGHTON PARK**

*Stirnie Road & Boughton Road*

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings.

## MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN


235 County Route 9

Located on Victor-Egypt Road (County Road 9), across from the Valentown Road intersection, this living classroom has an emphasis on preservation and restoration of New York State's official bird, the Bluebird. A one mile looped trail traverses the property through open fields and woods. This trail enables park visitors to see bluebirds in their natural habitat. The renovated Butler Cottage is available for family gatherings, parties or business meetings. Included is a newly constructed handicapped accessible fishing dock.
