



Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation...

Brian Emelson, CPRE, Director of Parks and Recreation

As we move into the holiday season and winter begins inching its way into our Victor community, I would like to give you some things to look forward to from the Department of Parks and Recreation in 2023!

You may recall that we completed a rigorous update to our Parks and Recreation Master Plan in 2019. Through a variety of public outreach opportunities, the Department and its' Parks and Recreation Citizens' Advisory Committee developed an improvement plan which will guide the Town in planning for the future. With more than 450 acres of parkland and more than 65 miles of multi-use trails, Victor's parks and recreation system is one of the richest in our area. Finding a balance between passive and active recreation lands within our community is a key factor outlined in the plan. Preserving the beauty and serenity of MaryFrances Bluebird Haven and Lehigh Crossing Park while encouraging opportunities for play at Dryer Road Park, Victor Municipal Park and the "future" Papparone Park should be seen as effective ways to find that balance!

One of the priority projects referenced in the updated master plan involved the development of a dog park at Harlan Fisher Park. This 6-acre, neighborhood park nestled in the Church Street – Lynaugh Road area provides us with a unique opportunity to create a walkable place to recreate and has the potential to be a great asset for the Village. In the spring of 2022, we completed the preliminary design of improvements to the park which included the "new" dog park. The dog park will include fenced in small and large dog areas, a double-gated entry system, a dog wash and water station, pet waste stations, dog play elements, a natural surface play area, benches and signage. The 1st phase of this project including the dog park area will begin construction this winter with the goal of opening it in the late fall of 2023 or the spring of 2024.

Two additional capital projects that the Department will embark upon this year, which are outlined in the master plan, include the expansion and improvements of the parking areas at Dryer Road Park and Victor Municipal Park. If you have taken in a summer concert at Victor Municipal Park or used the athletic fields or bike park and trails at Dryer Road Park, you understand that the parking areas can often be at or over capacity. This fall, our engineers at Labella Associates worked with park maintenance staff and I to develop plans for expanding the parking lots at each facility to accommodate current as well as future needs. These projects will be federally funded through the American Rescue Plan which was enacted during the Covid-19 pandemic. In addition, we will be making improvements to the picnic areas at MaryFrances Bluebird Haven, Lehigh Crossing Park and Fishers Park including shade structures and replacing bridge decking and railings as well as variety of trail improvements throughout the Victor network involving updated wayfinding signage, crosswalk enhancements, and opportunities for increased connectivity to our passive and active recreation spaces...all good things!

COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS



Introduction to Level 1:

This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are ready for more independence than the tot program. They will work on floating independently, flutter kicking and rolling over onto their back. These skills are essential in keeping this age group safe in both pools and lakes. 

AUBURN TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

BOUGHTON PARK

[Stirnie Road & Boughton Road](#)

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. Permits for the park can be obtained at Victor Town Clerks office, 85 East Main Street. Please bring proof of residency (NYS ID and car registration). The permits are free to Victor Residents.

DRYER ROAD PARK

[7405 Dryer Road](#)

This 132-acre park is the site of athletic fields and a box sports rink. There is a multiage playground for children, year-round restrooms facilities, and a picnic shelter, which is available for casual use or reservation. There are 15 miles of multi-use trails for a variety of skill levels and abilities. Please sign in at the trailhead kiosk and pick up a trail map prior to setting out to explore the trails. FISHERS PARK

Located in the hamlet of Fishers, this 93 acre park is a diversity of passive and active recreation opportunities. Visitors can see a multitude of wildlife from deer, squirrels, and other woodland creatures to waterfowl and trout that spawn in the spring. Two tennis courts are available for the tennis players in your family. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike. Trails meander through the park across wooded ridges, through wetland areas, and along the banks of Irondequoit Creek. LEHIGH CROSSING PARK

Lehigh Crossing Park is located off of Victor-Mendon Road (State Route 251) near Cork Road and Route 96. This 54 acre park plays host to several miles of multi-use trails, vehicle parking area and gazebo. MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN


235 County Route 9


VICTOR MUNICIPAL PARK
