# Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation...

**Brian Emelson, CPRE, Director of Parks and Recreation**

As we head into the spring and summer months in Victor, we have a great deal of fun activities and special events to share with you this season! I can also update you on several projects that we have been working on to improve your use of our parks, facilities and trail systems around the Town and Village.

This season, children and families can join us on May 13th for a Bike Festival & Rodeo at the Victor Recreation Center which is co-sponsored by our Department, its' Parks and Recreation Citizens' Advisory Committee and the Victor Central School District PTA's Wellness Committee. There will be a variety of cycling related activities including bike inspections, a "safety street", trail rides, prizes and treats! In addition, our annual Gone Fishing... Youth Fishing Derby will be held at Victor Municipal Park on June 17th! Young anglers can prepare for a fun-filled morning of casting their rods in hopes to reel in the BIG ONE! Registration for both of these events opens on April 24th, so sign up early!

Summer camps and activities include traditional activities including our Certified Day Camp and Swim Lesson program as well as sports and specialty camps in areas such as Cartooning, Mountain Biking, Soccer and Nature Exploration! Our Junior Golf League hits the links at Victor Hills G.C. in late June and the ever popular Trip Camp will visit places including Roseland Water Park and Seabreeze Amusement Park for some rides and slides! All of this information, plus our Sid Partington Memorial Concert Series and the newly created Taco Tuesday: Tacos, Trails and Ales Concert Series are detailed inside the pages of this Activity Guide.

The Department has several park improvements identified for its park and trail system this year in accord with our (2019) Parks and Recreation Master Plan. There will be major renovations to the parking lots at Dryer Road Park and Victor Municipal Park including expansion of the current parking areas, paving, striping, additional lighting and signage. We will begin construction this season on the Dog Park at Harlan Fisher Park, which will include small and large dog areas, agility features, a dog wash station, benches and site furnishings, wooded areas and pathways! This winter, our park maintenance staff completed the re-decking of the main trailhead bridge at Fishers Park, and we are in the process of installing a new roof on the barn at Mary Frances Bluebird Haven. On a sad note, Ken Waters, a longtime Victor resident and the former Ranger at Mary Frances Bluebird Haven, passed away late last year. Ken will always be remembered for the time he spent caring for the many bluebird boxes at the park as well as giving educational tours and celebrating the vision of Bob and Mary Frances Butler.

As we turn our attention to the warmer months, we are excited to celebrate the signs and sounds of spring and we are looking forward to your participation in many of the diverse activities that our Department offers and supports!



## LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

### Parent Child Classes (AGES 6 months-3 years):

30-minute classes, including parent/child engagement! During class we will work with parents to get their younger children comfortable and confident in and around water. Working on guided discovery of the water environment while being in the caring arms of a caregiver.

### TOT swim classes (AGES 3 - 4):

30-minute classes, smaller class size! Preschool age children will receive an introduction to water in a controlled and comfortable environment. During this class they will do focus on becoming more comfortable in and around the water environment. This is for children only (not parent/child) with a small class size.

### Introduction to Level 1:

This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are ready for more independence. They will work on floating independently, flutter kicking and rolling over onto their back. Upon passing this level, it is possible the child may be ready for level 2 (Instructor's discretion).

### Level 1 (Beginner 1):

If your child is under the age of 6, please refer to Intro to Level 1. Level 1 is for children who are able to stand in the shallow end independently. They will work on putting their face in the water, blowing bubbles and floating on their front or back.

### Level 2 (Beginner 2):

Children in this group can float and feel comfortable with their faces in the water but are still working on making independent forward progress.

### Level 3 (Beginner 3):

This group can swim in the shallow end with their faces in the water but continue to work on the confidence to feel comfortable in water over their head. This class has a large focus on learning front crawl, backstroke, and elementary backstroke.

### Level 4 (Advanced Beginner):

This class takes place in the deep end. Children will work on refining the front crawl and backstroke. Children will learn breaststroke and sidestroke.

### Level 5 (Intermediate):

Swimmers can rhythmic breathe on front crawl and perform the elementary backstroke but will continue to work on the breaststroke, sidestroke, and/or back crawl.

### Level 6 (Swimmer):

This group can perform the six basic strokes: front crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, back crawl and butterfly. Level 6 now has four components that will be covered in the lesson: Personal Water Safety, Pre-Lifeguard Training, Fitness Swimmer and Fundamentals of Diving.

# GET OUT AND EXPLORE VICTOR'S PARKS

## **AUBURN TRAIL**

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

## **BOUGHTON PARK**

*Stirnie Road & Boughton Road*

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. Permits for the park can be obtained at Victor Town Clerks office, 85 East Main Street. Please bring proof of residency (NYS ID and car registration). The permits are free to Victor Residents.

## **DRYER ROAD PARK**

*7405 Dryer Road*

This 132-acre park is the site of athletic fields and a box sports rink. There is a multiage playground for children, year-round restrooms facilities, and a picnic shelter, which is available for casual use or reservation. There are 15 miles of multi-use trails for a variety of skill levels and abilities. Please sign in at the trailhead kiosk and pick up a trail map prior to setting out to explore the trails. ## **FISHERS PARK**

*7929 Main Street, Fishers*

Located in the hamlet of Fishers, this 93 acre park is a diversity of passive and active recreation opportunities. Visitors can see a multitude of wildlife from deer, squirrels, and other woodland creatures to waterfowl and trout that spawn in the spring. Two tennis courts are available for the tennis players in your family. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike. Trails meander through the park across wooded ridges, through wetland areas, and along the banks of Irondequoit Creek. New acreage off Old Dutch Road provides you with many new trails with beautiful vistas. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike, snowshoe or cross-country ski.

## **LEHIGH CROSSING PARK**

*7350 State Route 251*

Lehigh Crossing Park is located off of Victor-Mendon Road (State Route 251) near Cork Road and Route 96. This 54 acre park plays host to several miles of multi-use trails, vehicle parking area and gazebo. With woods, wetlands and ponds located within this passive park, numerous birds, waterfowl and critters find this park an exceptional place to call home. Bring binoculars!

## **LEHIGH VALLEY TRAIL**

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings.

## **MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN**

*235 County Route 9*

Located on Victor-Egypt Road (County Road 9), across from the Valentown Road intersection, this living classroom has an emphasis on preservation and restoration of New York State's official bird, the Bluebird. A one mile looped trail traverses the property through open fields and woods. This trail enables park visitors to see bluebirds in their natural habitat. The renovated Butler Cottage is available for family gatherings, parties or business meetings. Included is a newly constructed handicapped accessible fishing dock.
