# Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation...

**Brian Emelson, CPRE, Director of Parks and Recreation**

What an outstanding summer of fun activities, cool recreation programs and park improvement projects our Department of Parks and Recreation was able to realize this year! I am very thankful to the many families, participants, and community groups we were able to serve through our day camps, swim lessons, concert series, lodge / shelter rentals and athletic field reservations this past season. I am equally proud of our full-time recreation and parks staff and our seasonal recreation leaders, recreation assistants and park / trails maintenance personnel who were the key to our success. In addition, we had the pleasure of hosting several bands and entertainers at our Sid Partington Memorial Concert in the Park series and our Taco Tuesday at DRP series with a diverse line-up acts unparalleled in our region. Kudos to the many food trucks, sweets and treats vendors and local breweries who supported our special events.

As you may have seen in your travels to Victor Municipal Park and Dryer Road Park this spring and summer, we had major parking lot renovation projects at both sites adding (50) vehicles spaces at Dryer and (100) seasonal parking spaces at Victor Municipal. We also installed additional lighting at both parks. I would like to thank our contractors Road-Tek and O'Connell Electric as well as our Town engineers at LaBella Associates for teaming with us on the project. We also updated the trailhead information area at Dryer, so be sure to check out the cool "new" vibe for launching your next trailside adventure!

Department staff coupled with tremendous volunteer support from Genesee Regional Off-Road Cyclists constructed a "new" gravity mountain bike trail in the southwest corner of the Dryer Road Park system and will be working on several additional projects this fall and in 2024! Victor Hiking Trails inducted the "Four Horseman" of the Victor trails system – Dave Wright, Chauncy Young, Larry Fisher and Jeff Hennick into their Hall of Fame class with Dryer Road Park trail system pioneer Rick Williams rounding out this years' class. The amount of grassroots, community projects that these individuals have been involved in for the past three decades is staggering. Through the work of Troop 341 Eagle Scout Douglas Tavolette and a generous donation from Barebo-Otterbein, we installed a pond aeration device at Mary Frances Bluebird Haven to improve the water quality and habitat of that pond. This project was initially conceived during the pandemic, so it is especially nice to see it come to fruition.

Please consider our Victor-Recreational Afterschool Program (V-RAP) for your Kindergartener to 5th grader as an option this fall. V-RAP operates in conjunction with the Victor Central School District calendar and offers specialized programming and trips on recess and school's out dates. Our 2nd annual "Monster Mash" Halloween Party will be held at the Recreation Center on Saturday, October 28th and we will celebrate our local Veterans with an appreciation luncheon at the Victor Town Hall on Thursday, November 9th with a performance from the Rochester Metropolitan Jazz Orchestra and a catered lunch from Fire on Main!

This fall, you will see construction activity at Harlan Fisher Park pick up pace with the earthwork, drainage, fencing, electrical and masonry work on our "new" Dog Park being completed in anticipation of a spring, 2024 grand opening. The one-acre, off-leash dog park will include small and large dog areas, a natural play space and trail, benches, dog wash station and gated access control system. More to come!

### Private Lessons (AGES 2-12):

30-minute classes with individual guidance in and around the water. Working at their own pace to get more confident and efficient in the swimming world.

### Parent Child Classes (AGES 6 months-3 years):

30-minute classes, including parent/child engagement! During class we will work with parents to get their younger children comfortable and confident in and around water. Working on guided discovery of the water environment while being in the caring arms of a caregiver.

### TOT swim classes (AGES 3 - 4):

30-minute classes, smaller class size! Preschool age children will receive an introduction to water in a controlled and comfortable environment. During this class they will focus on becoming more comfortable in and around the water environment. This is for children only (not parent/child) with a small class size.

### Introduction to Level 1:

This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are ready for more independence. They will work on floating independently, flutter kicking and rolling over onto their back. Upon passing this level, it is possible the child may be ready for level 2 (Instructor's discretion).

### Level 1 (Beginner 1):

If your child is under the age of 6, please refer to Intro to Level 1. Level 1 is for children who are able to stand in the shallow end independently. They will work on putting their face in the water, blowing bubbles and floating on their front or back.

### Level 2 (Beginner 2):

Children in this group can float and feel comfortable with their faces in the water, but are still working on making independent forward progress.

### Level 3 (Beginner 3):

This group can swim in the shallow end with their faces in the water but continue to work on the confidence to feel comfortable in water over their head. This class has a large focus on learning front crawl, backstroke, and elementary backstroke.

### Level 4 (Advanced Beginner):

This class takes place in the deep end. Children will work on refining the front crawl and backstroke. Children will learn breaststroke and sidestroke.

### Level 5 (Intermediate):

Swimmers can rhythmic breathe on front crawl and perform the elementary backstroke but will continue to work on the breaststroke, sidestroke, and/or back crawl.

### Level 6 (Swimmer):

This group can perform the six basic strokes: front crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, back crawl and butterfly. Level 6 now has four components that will be covered in the lesson: Personal Water Safety, Pre-Lifeguard Training, Fitness Swimmer and Fundamentals of Diving.







# GET OUT AND EXPLORE **VICTOR'S PARKS**



## **AUBURN TRAIL**

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

## **BOUGHTON PARK**

*Stirnie Road & Boughton Road*

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. Permits for the park can be obtained at Victor Town Clerks office, 85 East Main Street. Please bring proof of residency (NYS ID and car registration). The permits are free to Victor Residents.

## **DRYER ROAD PARK**

*7405 Dryer Road*

This 132-acre park is the site of athletic fields and a box sports rink. There is a multiage playground for children, year-round restrooms facilities, and a picnic shelter, which is available for casual use or reservation. There are 15 miles of multi-use trails for a variety of skill levels and abilities. Please sign in at the trailhead kiosk and pick up a trail map prior to setting out to explore the trails. The park links Victor's Native American past with our future with pathways to Ganondagan State Historic Site. ## **FISHERS PARK**

*7929 Main Street, Fishers*

Located in the hamlet of Fishers, this 93 acre park is a diversity of passive and active recreation opportunities. Visitors can see a multitude of wildlife from deer, squirrels, and other woodland creatures to waterfowl and trout that spawn in the spring. Two tennis courts are available for the tennis players in your family. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike. Trails meander through the park across wooded ridges, through wetland areas, and along the banks of Irondequoit Creek. New acreage off Old Dutch Road provides you with many new trails with beautiful vistas. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike, snowshoe or cross-country ski.

## **LEHIGH CROSSING PARK**

*7350 State Route 251*

Lehigh Crossing Park is located off of Victor-Mendon Road (State Route 251) near Cork Road and Route 96. This 54 acre park plays host to several miles of multi-use trails, vehicle parking area and gazebo. With woods, wetlands and ponds located within this passive park, numerous birds, waterfowl and critters find this park an exceptional place to call home. Bring binoculars!

## LEHIGH VALLEY TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings.

## MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN

235 County Route 9

Located on Victor-Egypt Road (County Road 9), across from the Valentown Road intersection, this living classroom has an emphasis on preservation and restoration of New York State's official bird, the Bluebird. A one mile looped trail traverses the property through open fields and woods. This trail enables park visitors to see bluebirds in their natural habitat. The renovated Butler Cottage is available for family gatherings, parties or business meetings. Included is a newly constructed handicapped accessible fishing dock.
