Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation...

Perhaps “Punxsutawney Phil” the groundhog made the right call this year as it seemed like we went straight from fall into spring without stopping at winter? And while that may have disappointed the skiers, the snowboarders, and the snowman makers; it offered our parks and recreation staff the opportunity to get a jump on several “new” projects and wildly popular programs that will come your way this spring and summer!

In 2022, we began the design development phase for the improvements associated with **Harlan Fisher Park** in the Village. This 7-acre park nestled in the Victorwood neighborhood was recognized in the 2019 Parks and Recreation Master Plan update as a priority project by the community. Last July, we began construction on the 1st phase of improvements including a “new” **off-leash dog park**, site utilities and updated landscaping plan. I’m excited to share that the off-leash dog park will open to residents on Saturday, June 29th! The park features small and large dog areas, play and agility features, a woodland trail, pet fountains and a pet wash station and a variety of new trees and shrubs which will complement the existing forested areas of the park.

On April 20th, community members and groups are invited to join us for an **Arbor Day Celebration** at Harlan Fisher Park where we will be planting over (25) “new” trees courtesy of our teammates at the Victor Tree Board and the benevolence of **Kitty Van Bortel** and **Van Bortel Subaru**. This event will give you and sneak peek of good things to follow later this spring when the off-leash dog park is dedicated to the community. Additional sponsorship support for the dog park comes from longtime Victor residents **Renee** and **Justin** from **Victor Pest Management** whose generosity is making it possible for many of the related site improvements to become a reality! Kudos also to **Mark Palumbo** at **Victor’s Self Serve Pet Wash** who provided the pet waste stations for our “bark park.”

If you would like to register yourself and your pooch for a pass to the off-leash dog park, please stop in the Town Clerk’s office to sign up. There is an annual permit fee of \$30 to use the off-leashed dog areas and you will also need a current copy of your dog(s) license and rabies certificate. We are extremely excited to bring this new asset to our park system and the Victor community!

In closing, I’d like to thank **Mary Duprey** for her numerous years as President of the **Victor Garden Club** and the collaborative relationship we have built. Mary has been responsible for advocating and developing a variety of civic beautification projects in the Town and Village including the numerous public flower beds, colorful hanging baskets, and appealing sidewalk planters and pots throughout our community. Mary has been a tireless advocate for parks and recreation activities and has served on the Community Roundtable group which shares the many wonderful attributes of Victor...most importantly its people. While our department will continue to work with the Victor Garden Club on the annual plantings and flowerpot fundraiser event for the club, we would like to thank Mary for her leadership and shared vision.

KIDS (AND FAMILY) FRIENDLY BIKE FEST

The Victor Parks and Recreation, Citizens' Advisory Committee with the support of the Victor PTSA, is pleased to present a fun cycling activity for Victor kids, ages 5-18 years old and their families. Experienced volunteer cyclists will do a quick safety check on your bikes and make needed adjustments. Younger, less experienced cyclists are invited to participate in a Bike Rodeo to learn about Bike Safety and work on Basic Bike Handling Skills. A ride to Mendon, (approx. 3 miles, round trip) will take place after the Rodeo on the Lehigh Trail where we'll stop for a snack at the Mendon Ice S'coops! Older, more experienced riders are invited to participate in a longer ride on the Lehigh, which will also include a stop at the Mendon Ice S'coops. All rides will be led (and swept) by experienced adult cyclists. There will be Swag for your bikes. Helmets are required. Private Lessons (AGES 2-12):

30-minute classes with individual guidance in and around the water. Working at their own pace to get more confident and efficient in the swimming world.

Parent Child Classes (AGES 6 months-3 years):

30-minute classes, including parent/child engagement! During class we will work with parents to get their younger children comfortable and confident in and around water. Working on guided discovery of the water environment while being in the caring arms of a caregiver.

TOT swim classes (AGES 3 - 4):

30-minute classes, smaller class size! Preschool age children will receive an introduction to water in a controlled and comfortable environment. During this class they will focus on becoming more comfortable in and around the water environment. This is for children only (not parent/child) with a small class size.

Introduction to Level 1:

This is for children 4-5 years old who are unable to stand in the shallow end but are ready for more independence. They will work on floating independently, flutter kicking and rolling over onto their back. Upon passing this level, it is possible the child may be ready for level 2 (Instructor's discretion).

Level 1 (Beginner 1):

If your child is under the age of 6, please refer to Intro to Level 1. Level 1 is for children who are able to stand in the shallow end independently. They will work on putting their face in the water, blowing bubbles, and floating on their front or back.

Level 2 (Beginner 2):

Children in this group can float and feel comfortable with their faces in the water but are still working on making independent forward progress.

Level 3 (Beginner 3):

This group can swim in the shallow end with their faces in the water but continue to work on the confidence to feel comfortable in water over their head. This class has a large focus on learning front crawl, backstroke, and elementary backstroke.

Level 4 (Advanced Beginner):

This class takes place in the deep end. Children will work on refining the front crawl and backstroke. Children will learn breaststroke and sidestroke.

Level 5 (Intermediate):

Swimmers can rhythmic breathe on front crawl and perform the elementary backstroke but will continue to work on the breaststroke, sidestroke, and/or back crawl.

Level 6 (Swimmer):

This group can perform the six basic strokes: front crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke, back crawl, and butterfly. Level 6 now has four components that will be covered in the lesson: Personal Water Safety, Pre-Lifeguard Training, Fitness Swimmer, and Fundamentals of Diving.

GET OUT AND EXPLORE **VICTOR'S PARKS**



AUBURN TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

BOUGHTON PARK

Stirnie Road & Boughton Road

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. Permits for the park can be obtained at Victor Town Clerks office, 85 East Main Street. Please bring proof of residency (NYS ID and car registration). The permits are free to Victor Residents.

DRYER ROAD PARK

7405 Dryer Road

This 132-acre park is the site of athletic fields and a box sports rink. There is a multiage playground for children, year-round restrooms facilities, and a picnic shelter, which is available for casual use or reservation. There are 15 miles of multi-use trails for a variety of skill levels and abilities. Please sign in at the trailhead kiosk and pick up a trail map prior to setting out to explore the trails. The park links Victor's Native American past with our future with pathways to Ganondagan State Historic Site. Trail maps can also be downloaded at www.mygroc.com and www.VictorNY.org.

FISHERS PARK

7929 Main Street, Fishers

Located in the hamlet of Fishers, this 93 acre park is a diversity of passive and active recreation opportunities. Visitors can see a multitude of wildlife from deer, squirrels, and other woodland creatures to waterfowl and trout that spawn in the spring. Two tennis courts are available for the tennis players in your family. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike. Trails meander through the park across wooded ridges, through wetland areas, and along the banks of Irondequoit Creek. New acreage off Old Dutch Road provides you with many new trails with beautiful vistas. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike, snowshoe or cross-country ski.

LEHIGH CROSSING PARK

7350 State Route 251

Lehigh Crossing Park is located off of Victor-Mendon Road (State Route 251) near Cork Road and Route 96. This 54 acre park plays host to several miles of multi-use trails, vehicle parking area and gazebo. With woods, wetlands and ponds located within this passive park, numerous birds, waterfowl and critters find this park an exceptional place to call home. Bring binoculars!

LEHIGH VALLEY TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings.

MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN


235 County Route 9

Located on Victor-Egypt Road (County Road 9), across from the Valentown Road intersection, this living classroom has an emphasis on preservation and restoration of New York State's official bird, the Bluebird. A one mile looped trail traverses the property through open fields and woods. This trail enables park visitors to see bluebirds in their natural habitat.
