



Leisure Lines from the Director of Parks and Recreation...

As our summer adventures draw to a close, activity throughout the Department of Parks and Recreation continues to be brisk! In late June, we opened the first phase of improvements to Harlan Fisher Park with the dedication of the “new” off-leash dog park and related improvements including several pathways, numerous gardens replete with over four-hundred trees, plants and perennials, benches, trash receptacles and a canopy picnic-table. This was a special project for the Department’s Park Operations Staff with us acting as the general contractor and construction supervisor. Many thanks to our contractors, including New York State Fence, Colacino Industries and Pooler Enterprises as well as Bayer Landscape Architecture who developed the Park’s design and supported our team throughout the project! When you visit the park, you will see that this is not your “traditional” dog park but a park project that has transformed the Victorwood neighborhood that it shares.

In conjunction with our summer day camps, aquatics program and special events, we employed over one-hundred part-time and seasonal recreation staff. This is an important role that we play in the Victor community by not only being a service provider, but also facilitating career training, personal growth and development opportunities while knitting today’s leaders with tomorrow’s leaders! Special thanks to staff including Codie Fisk, Miranda Berdy, Cassandra Means, Dylan Geiss and Emmie Gurnell who comprised the summer program leadership group. In addition, we are fortunate to have several seasonal park staff join us in the crucial summer season including Trevor Knapp, Annalyse Sullivan and Troy Paige.

This summer, we installed public access, Automatic External Defibrillators (AED’s) at Dryer Road Park, Victor Municipal Park, Mary Frances Bluebird Haven and Fishers Park. This project was federally funded through the Town’s American Rescue Plan allocation and supported by a grant from the Victor-Farmington Ambulance. Kudos to Jared Palmer and Robert Merkel from the V-F Ambulance and Tina Kolaczyk, from the Town’s Human Resources office for all your work toward making this critical and potential life-saving project a reality!

This fall, we feature community events including the “Climb Aboard Victor” event in September, a “Monster Mash” Halloween Party in October, and a Veterans Appreciation Luncheon in November. Our team will provide recreation activities for youth including our basketball league and “V-RAP” recreational afterschool program and adult programming including yoga and pickleball instruction. All the necessary details are located within this recreation brochure, but if you have an idea for something “new”, be sure to send it our way. Thanks for your ongoing participation, your stewardship of our natural spaces and your confidence in our team to deliver these services!



GET OUT AND EXPLORE **VICTOR'S PARKS**



AUBURN TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington.

BOUGHTON PARK

Stirnie Road & Boughton Road

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. Permits for the park can be obtained at Victor Town Clerks office, 85 East Main Street. Please bring proof of residency (NYS ID and car registration). The permits are free to Victor Residents.

DRYER ROAD PARK

7405 Dryer Road

This 132-acre park is the site of athletic fields and a box sports rink. There is a multiage playground for children, year-round restrooms facilities, and a picnic shelter, which is available for casual use or reservation. There are 15 miles of multi-use trails for a variety of skill levels and abilities. Please sign in at the trailhead kiosk and pick up a trail map prior to setting out to explore the trails. The park links Victor's Native American past with our future with pathways to Ganondagan State Historic Site. Trail maps can also be downloaded at www.mygroc.com and www.VictorNY.org.

FISHERS PARK

7929 Main Street, Fishers

Located in the hamlet of Fishers, this 93 acre park is a diversity of passive and active recreation opportunities. Visitors can see a multitude of wildlife from deer, squirrels, and other woodland creatures to waterfowl and trout that spawn in the spring. Two tennis courts are available for the tennis players in your family. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike. Trails meander through the park across wooded ridges, through wetland areas, and along the banks of Irondequoit Creek. New acreage off Old Dutch Road provides you with many new trails with beautiful vistas. The extensive trail system is a great place to hike, snowshoe or cross-country ski.

LEHIGH CROSSING PARK

7350 State Route 251

Lehigh Crossing Park is located off of Victor-Mendon Road (State Route 251) near Cork Road and Route 96. This 54 acre park plays host to several miles of multi-use trails, vehicle parking area and gazebo. With woods, wetlands and ponds located within this passive park, numerous birds, waterfowl and critters find this park an exceptional place to call home. Bring binoculars!

ENJOY AND EXPERIENCE VICTOR'S PARKS

LEHIGH VALLEY TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings.

MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN

235 County Route 9

Located on Victor-Egypt Road (County Road 9), across from the Valentown Road intersection, this living classroom has an emphasis on preservation and restoration of New York State's official bird, the Bluebird. A one mile looped trail traverses the property through open fields and woods. This trail enables park visitors to see bluebirds in their natural habitat. The renovated Butler Cottage is available for family gatherings, parties or business meetings. Included is a newly constructed handicapped accessible fishing dock.
