I am the Applicant for a renewal license to conduct a Going Out of Business Sale located at:

I am aware that the \$425.00 certified check will be held by the Town Clerk until I notify the Town Clerk in writing that the sale has ended and submit a Final Inventory Statement at which time \$425.00 will be refunded to the Applicant if the Application has not otherwise been denied or revoked, the sale has concluded in compliance with NY Law, and the store has closed within 60 days of the issuance of the License.

I am aware that to extend the sale for additional 30 days a Non-refundable certified check for \$50.00 and this affidavit must be submitted within minimum of 10 days prior to the expiration of Original License.
